**Reunion Follow-Up Measures:**

- 1) **Reunion Date:** As many of you know, we received a couple of emails on Facebook from classmates regarding the possibility of changing our class reunion date from Arkalalah Weekend to a more suitable timeframe in the summer so Classmates could participate in activities and avoid losing quality time with children and grandchildren around Arkalalah. In fact, to help justify measuring attendance at another suitable timeframe, a survey was mentioned to be introduced to help solicit feedback from all classmates via email, Facebook, etc. that would help the committee gather data to make a more informed decision on a preferred summer date or weekend. However, the reunion committee supported its initial decision with adhering to the following:
  - a) Classmates in attendance at our Saturday Night Reunion Dinner voted unanimously, with no one in opposition to continue celebrating our class reunion on Arkalalah Weekend at the VFW.
  - b) The committee believes there is some validity with classmates wanting to spend quality time with family during Arkalalah. But, some of those responding purposely boycotted or chose to party at other locations without their family.
  - c) The reunion committee met every other week from July till reunion weekend to plan a successful reunion, and it is believed that everyone had an opportunity to voice their concern via Facebook, or attend in person with an actual meeting.
  - d) It would be totally unfair and unpopular to classmates to have their voice overturned once they voted, and, who willfully chose to leave politics out of their decision to attend our reunion to enjoy fellowship and reunite with classmates.
  - e) The committee believes the survey should be initiated that reflects how we can incorporate more activities for classmates to participate in as a whole group such as tours of the new football field, Ark Light and Mirror classroom, Boys Island, or any other activity that brings back fond high school memories, etc.
  - f) Since we host a reunion every five years, the committee believes it's not asking much for classmates to plan and give one day of their busy schedule within five years to attend a reunion function. Hereto, the committee understands we may always hear excuses as to why one would or cannot attend. Therefore, it's understandable to note that no date may be suitable to a select few.
  
- 2) **Check Account Deposits:** To free Jim Ramirez of extra duties and time associated with being Chairman, the reunion committee voted to name three new classmates to oversee our checking account. Names to appear onto a new signature card and named as Authorized Agents are Velta Gilmore, Peggy McClure and Rose Anstine. Agents replaced will be Jim Ramirez and Wilma Fortner. This safeguard practice ensures all transactions require at least two signatures for proper processing and creates a healthy and accurate accountability system of all deposits and withdraws. If one notes, for just-in-time convenience, all three Agents reside in Ark City.
